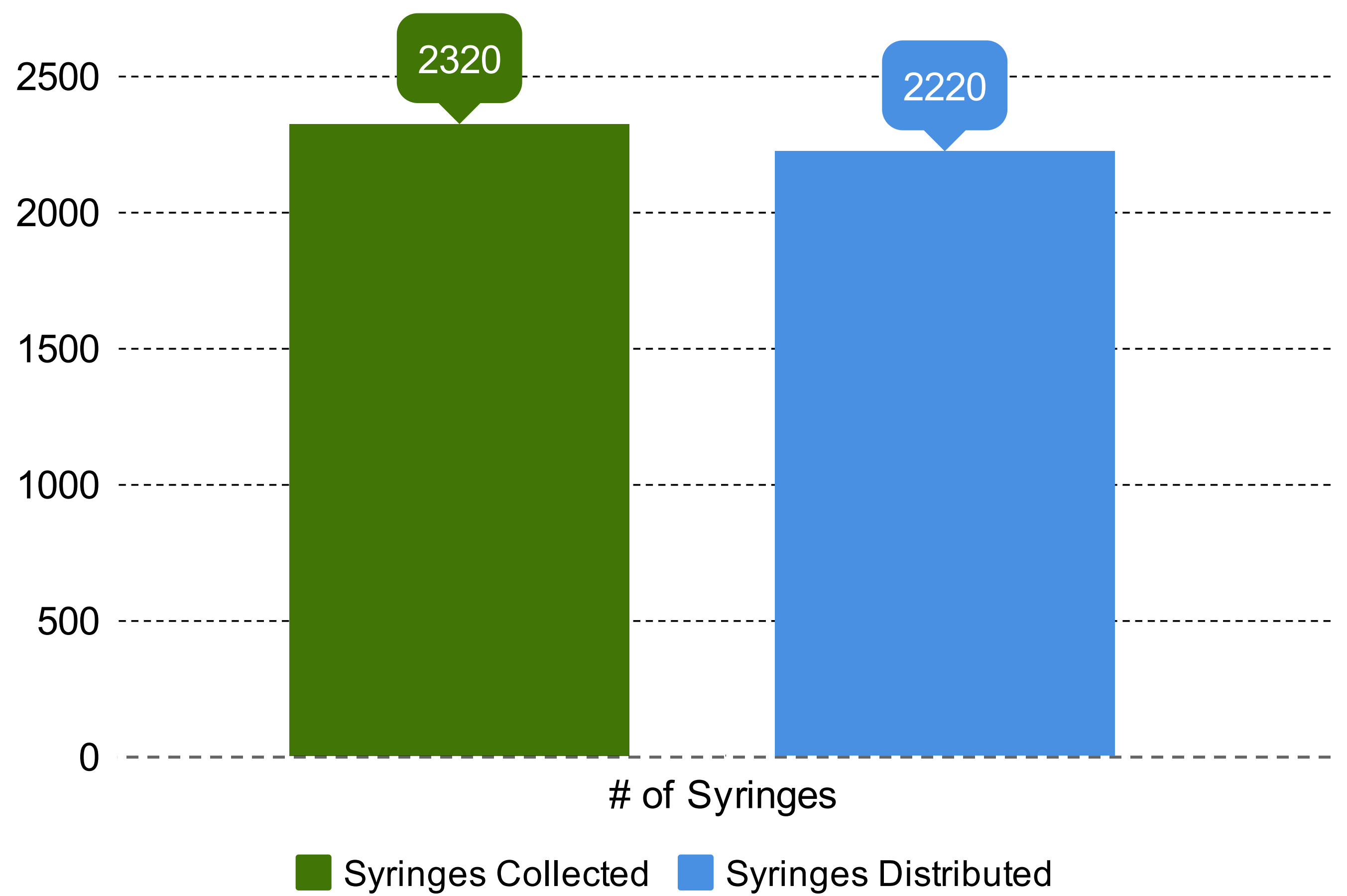

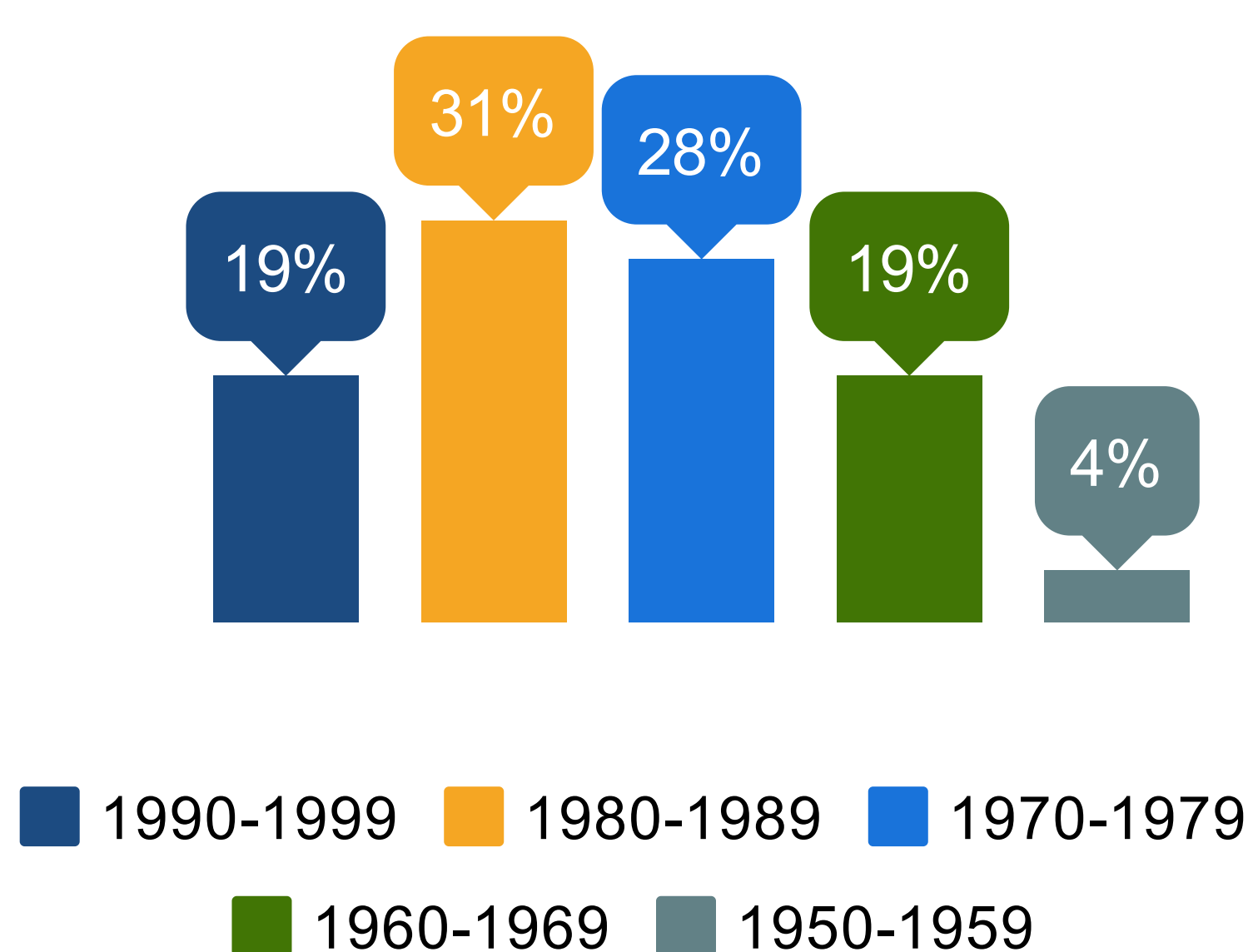

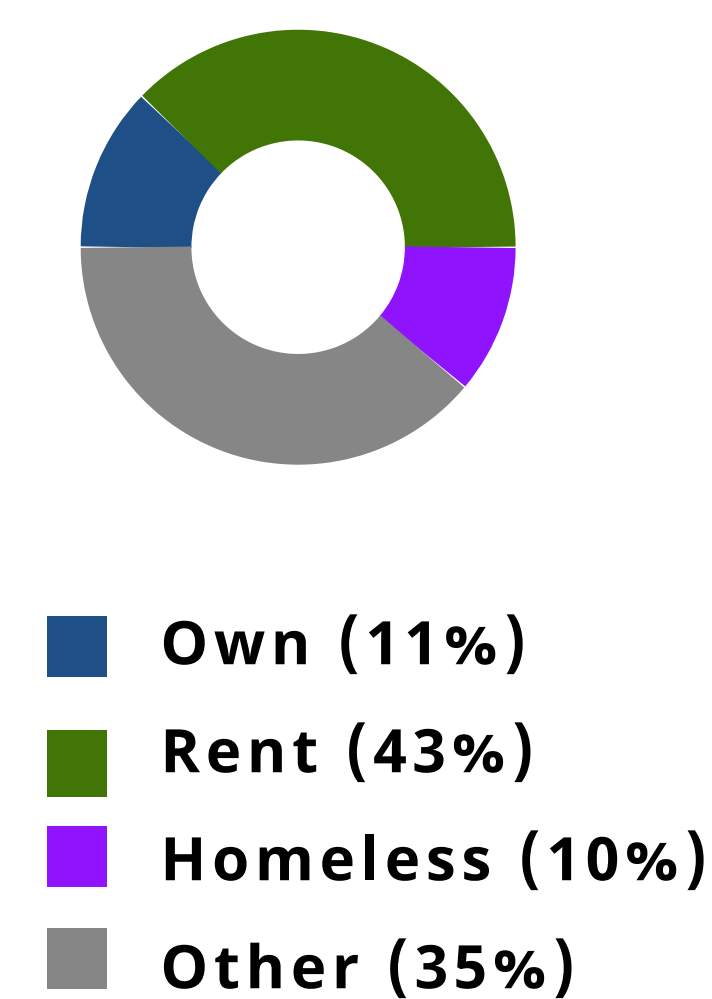
Participant Age Range



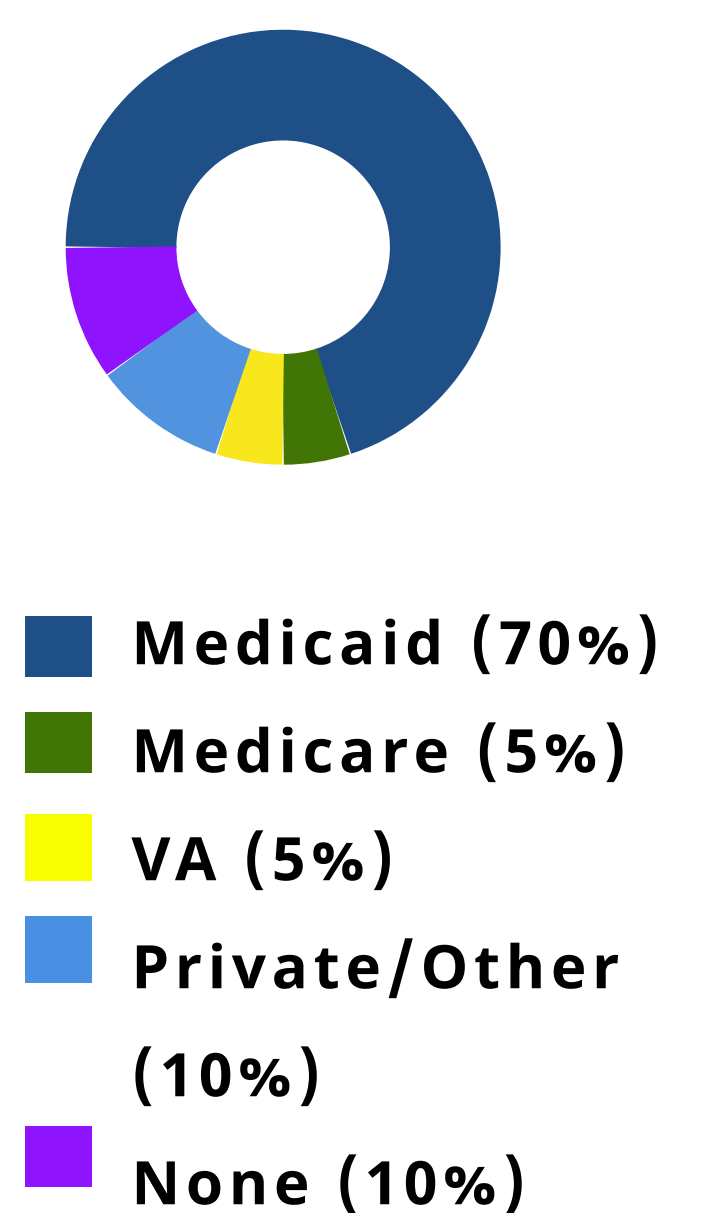
