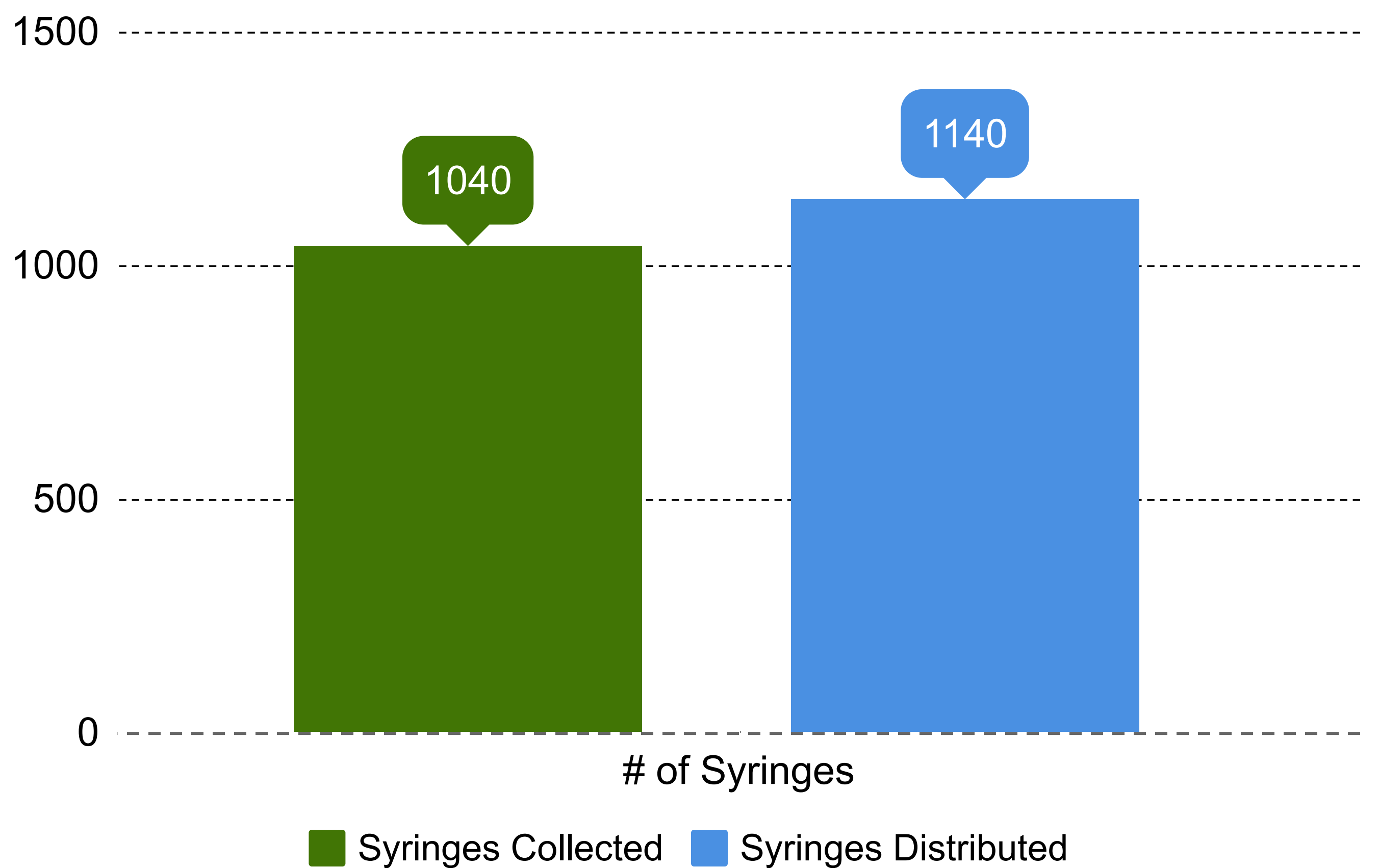

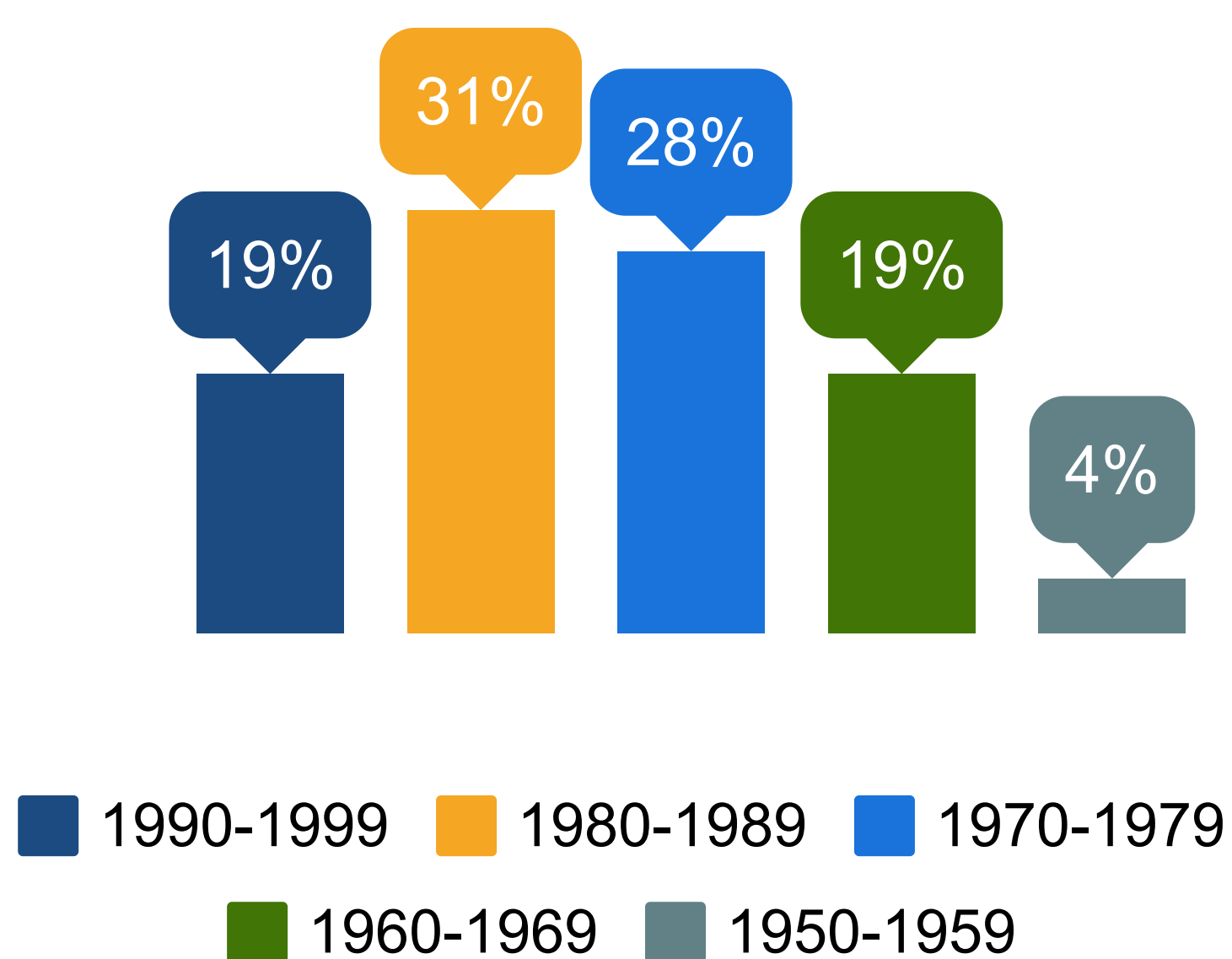

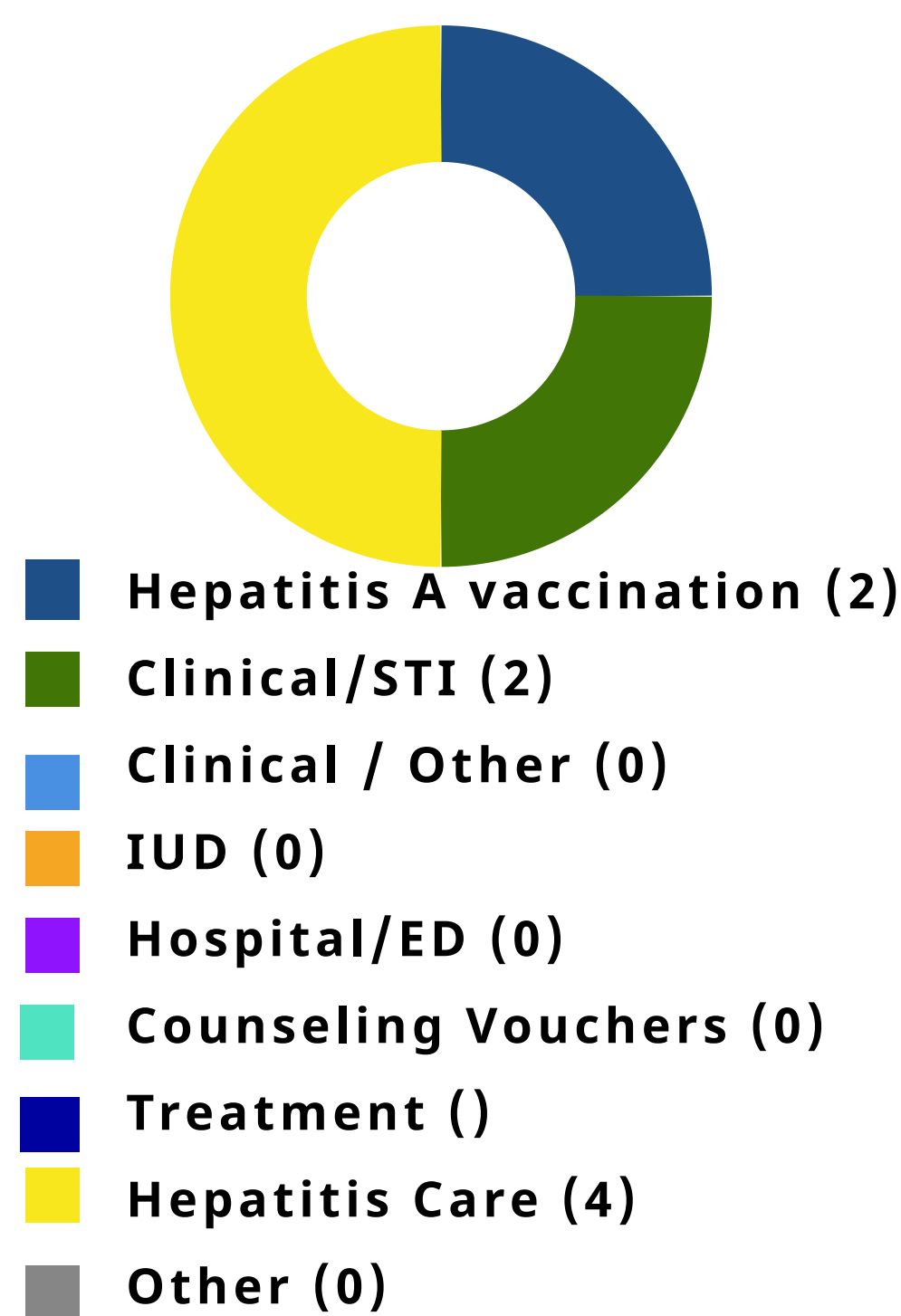

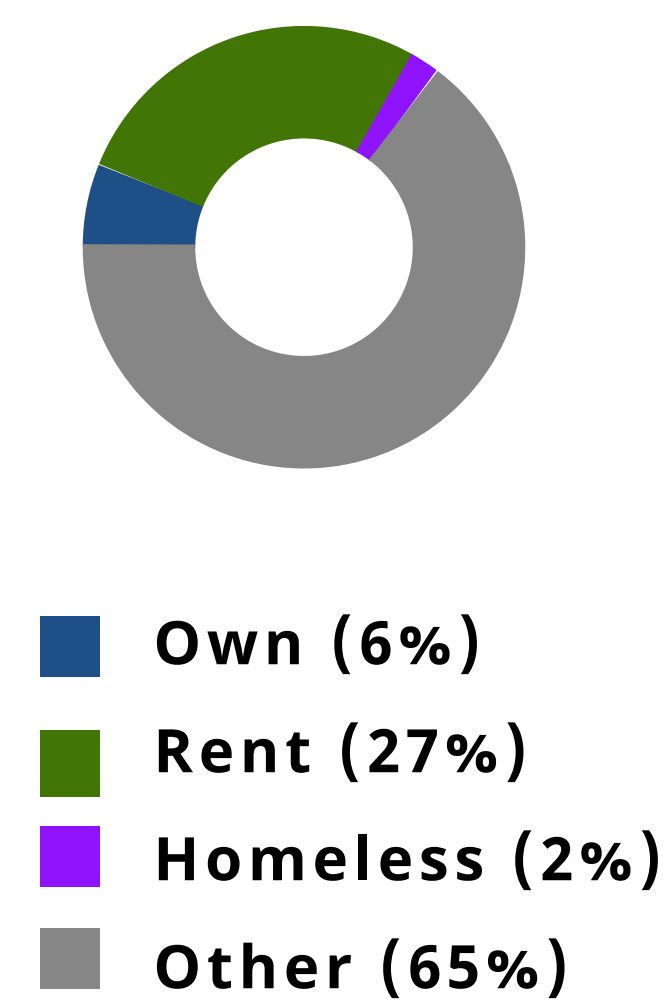
Participant Age Range



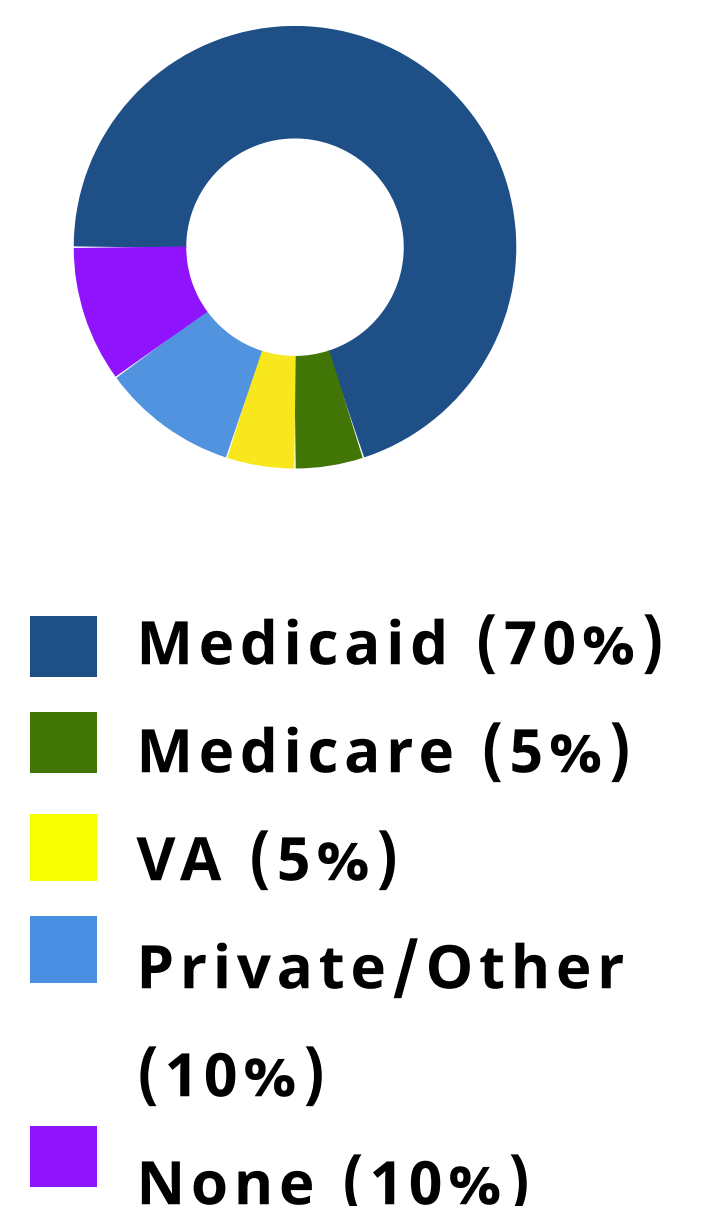
