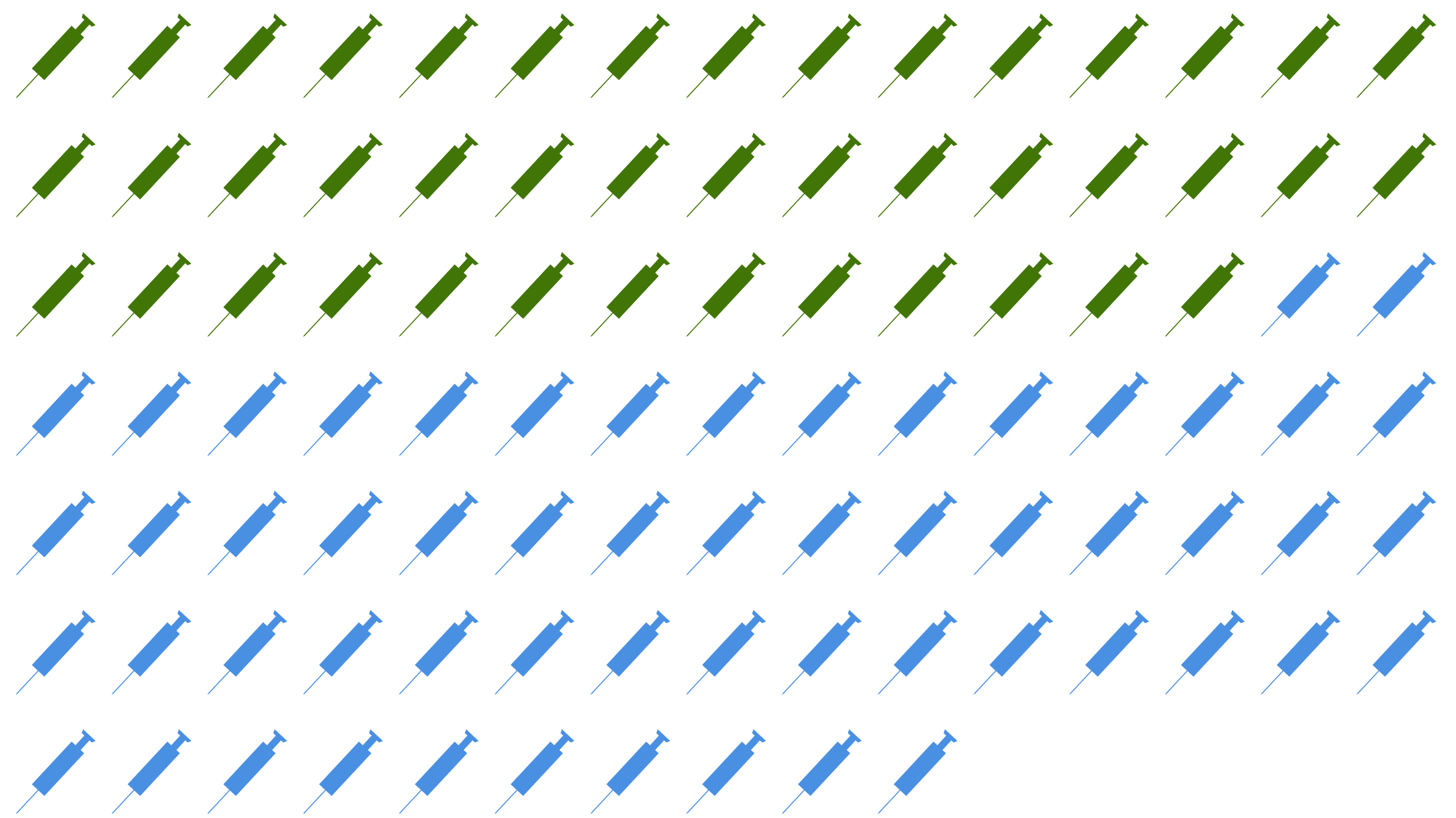

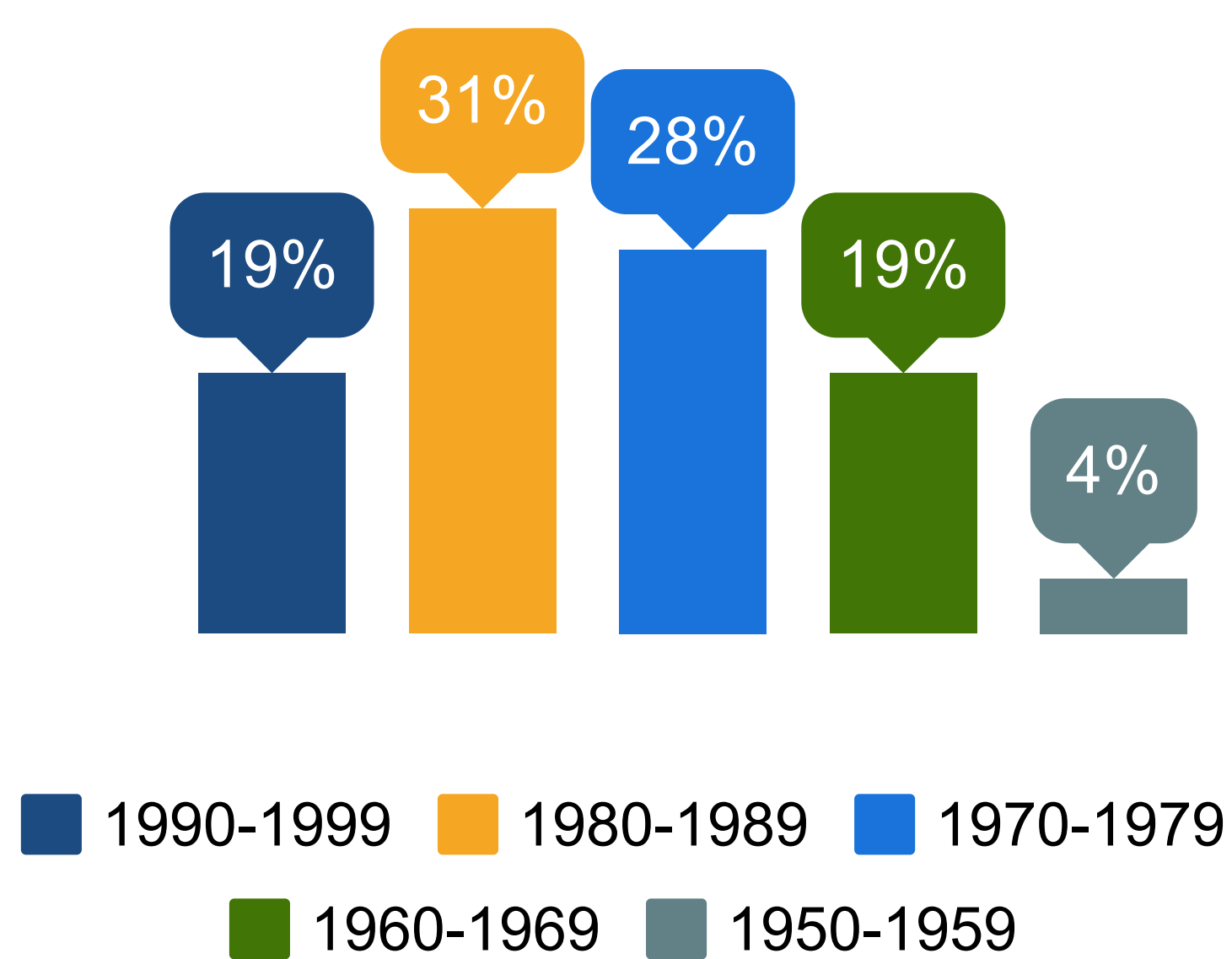

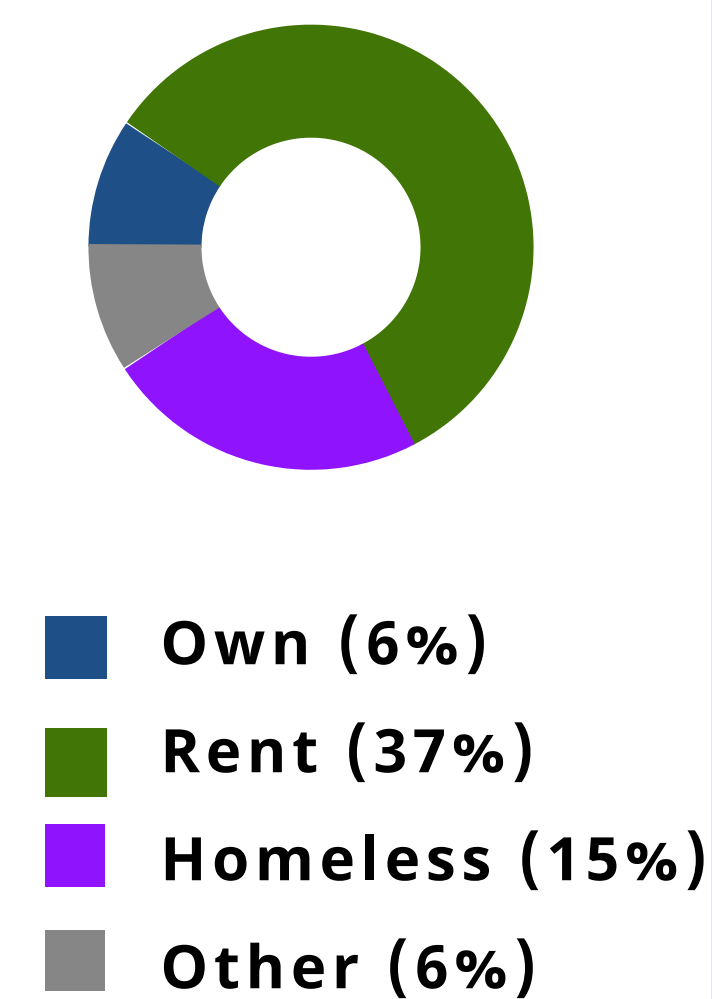
## Participant Age Range



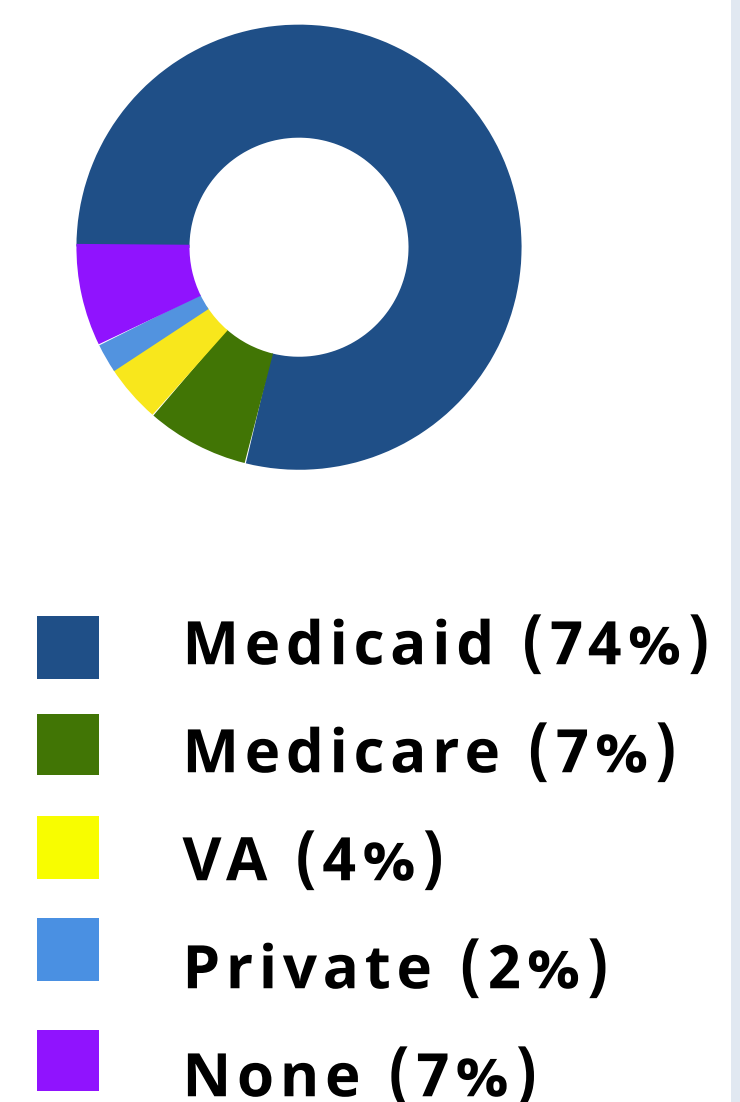
