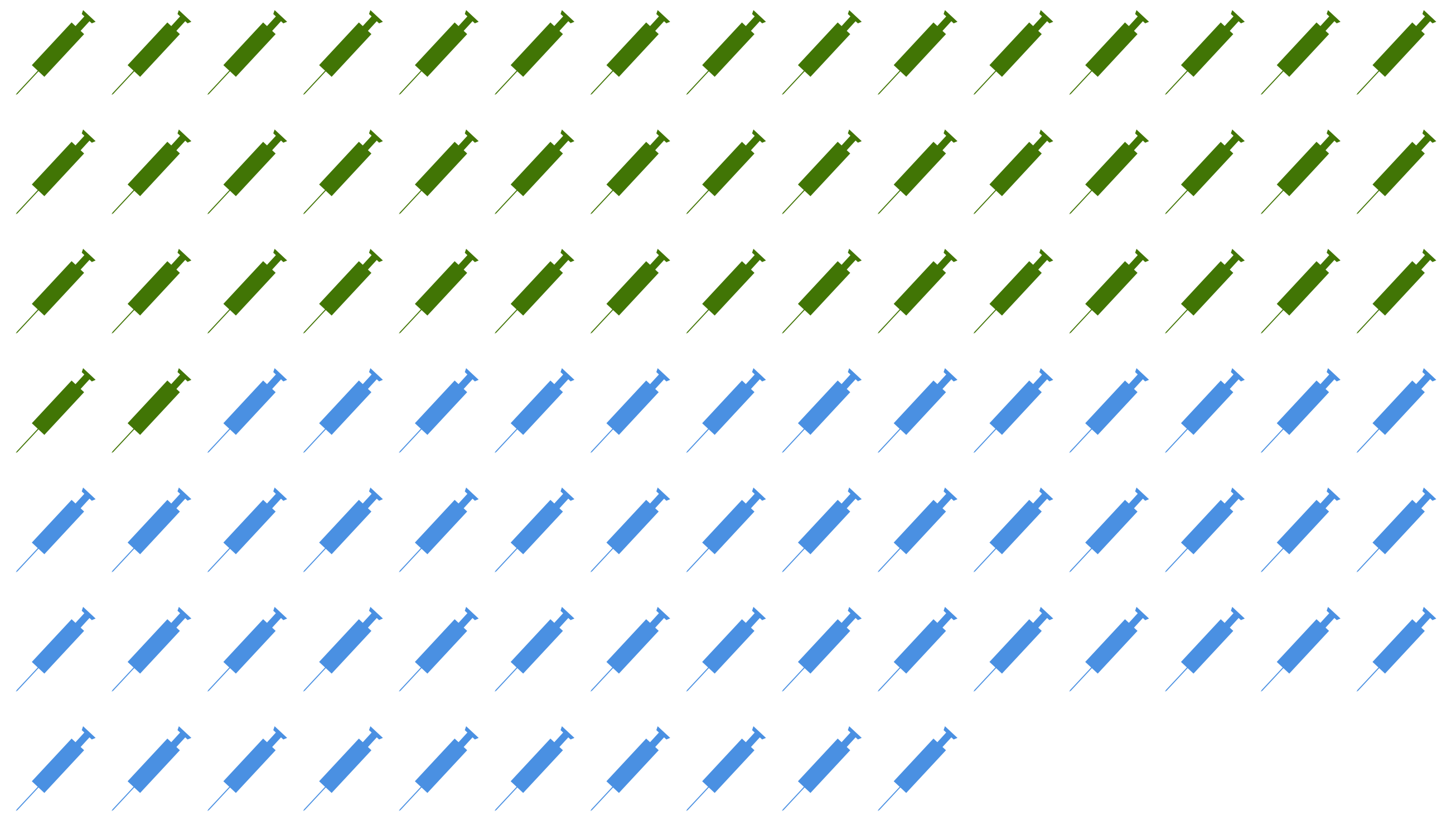

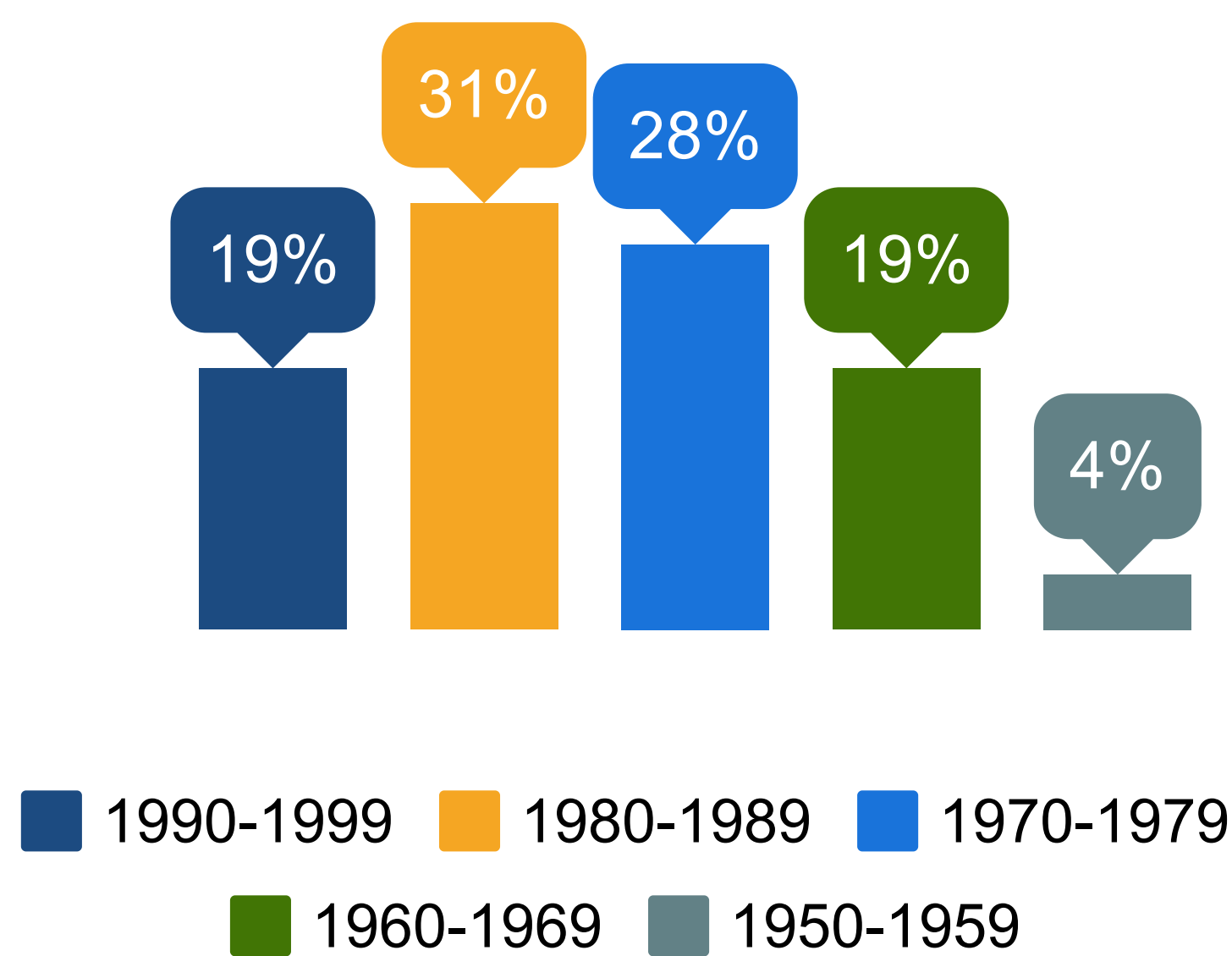

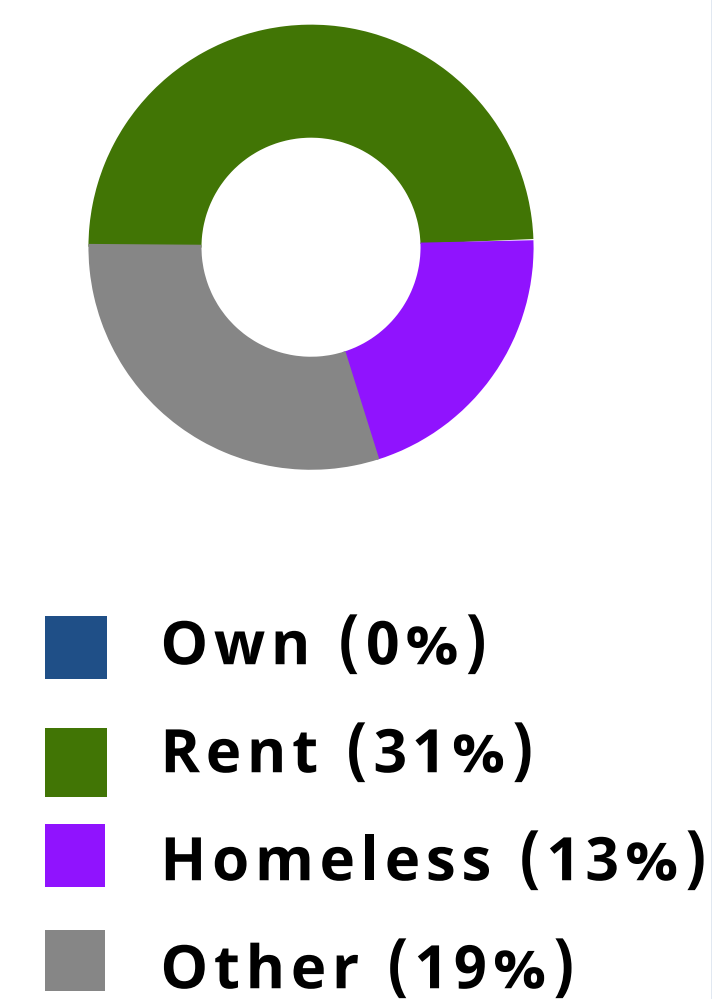
### Participant Age Range



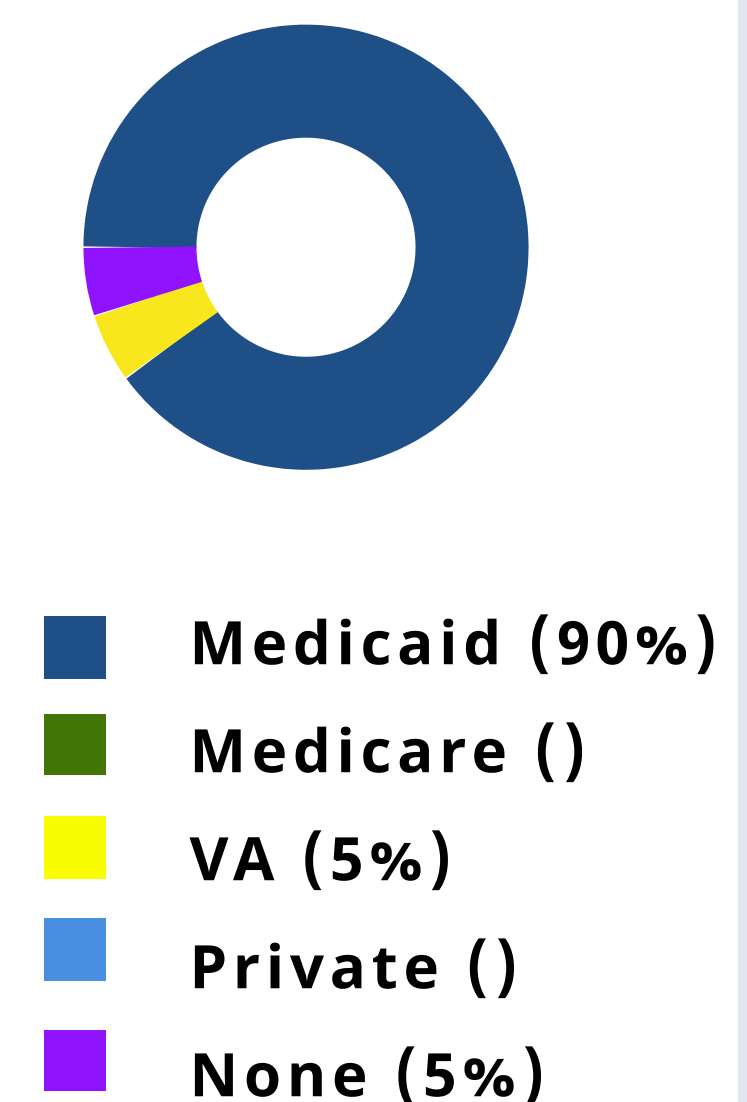
